

BRIANA MARIE COX FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

About the Briana Marie Cox Foundation Scholarship

The purpose of the scholarship is to help others triumph over loss by giving hope for the future at a time when it is much needed. Awarding college scholarships to deserving high school seniors is one way the Foundation can do its part.

Amount of Award:

A one time, non-renewable, award of \$3,000 will be paid to the school for which the recipient provides proof of enrollment. Awards will be presented by mid-May at a ceremony for which the date and time are to be determined.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

For any high school senior who, in their lifetime, has lost a parent, legal guardian, or sibling. Proof of loss in the form of a copy of the death certificate, or equivalent legal document, is required.

The student must be enrolled in a public or private high school in Palm Beach or Martin County, Florida.

Financial need is not a consideration.

Judging:

Judging will be based on each applicant's overall prior and continuing achievements, including activity in school organizations, the community, and athletics, as well as their academic record, and interviews in which the applicants will discuss their career plans and personal aspirations.

Some special consideration will be given to those interested in pursuing a medical career or career in the ministry (these were Briana's interests).

**GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING
THE BRIANA MARIE COX SCHOLARSHIP
APPLICATION FORM**

1. Submit seven (7) - (an original and 6 copies) - packets of materials. Each packet should be stapled together (no binders or folders) and be printed on 8 1/2" x 11" plain white paper. The packets may not have more than 20 single-sided pages (no cover or top sheets, please).

All packets **must** include the following in this order:

- a. Completed 2012 Application Form with all signatures
 - b. A verifiable statement of loss including certification (i.e. death certificate)
 - c. A verifiable recommendation letter from Principal, Guidance Counselor, or Teacher
 - d. A verifiable recommendation letter from a Community Leader (i.e. Clergy, Public Official, etc...)
 - e. A list of applicant's accomplishments, extracurricular activities, and other important achievements
 - f. A 400-500 word essay describing the applicant and their future goals***
 - g. A list of schools or colleges where the applicant has applied and the applicant's planned course of study
 - h. Examples of applicant's work or achievements related to the principles of the Briana Marie Cox Foundation
 - i. An original transcript (please do not leave it in an envelope)
2. Photos: Two (2) color professional wallet sized photographs. No scanned or color copied photos.
 - a. Write name, school, and "BMC Scholarship" on back of pictures with indelible ink.
 - b. Tape one photo to the front of the original Application Form, place other photo in an envelope and include with your packets.
 - c. Send your best photos - your photo may be included in Foundation promotional material
 3. Type all requested information.

We will not accept any videotapes, scrapbooks, slides, cassettes, DVD's/CD's, or rolled artwork. No submitted materials will be returned.
